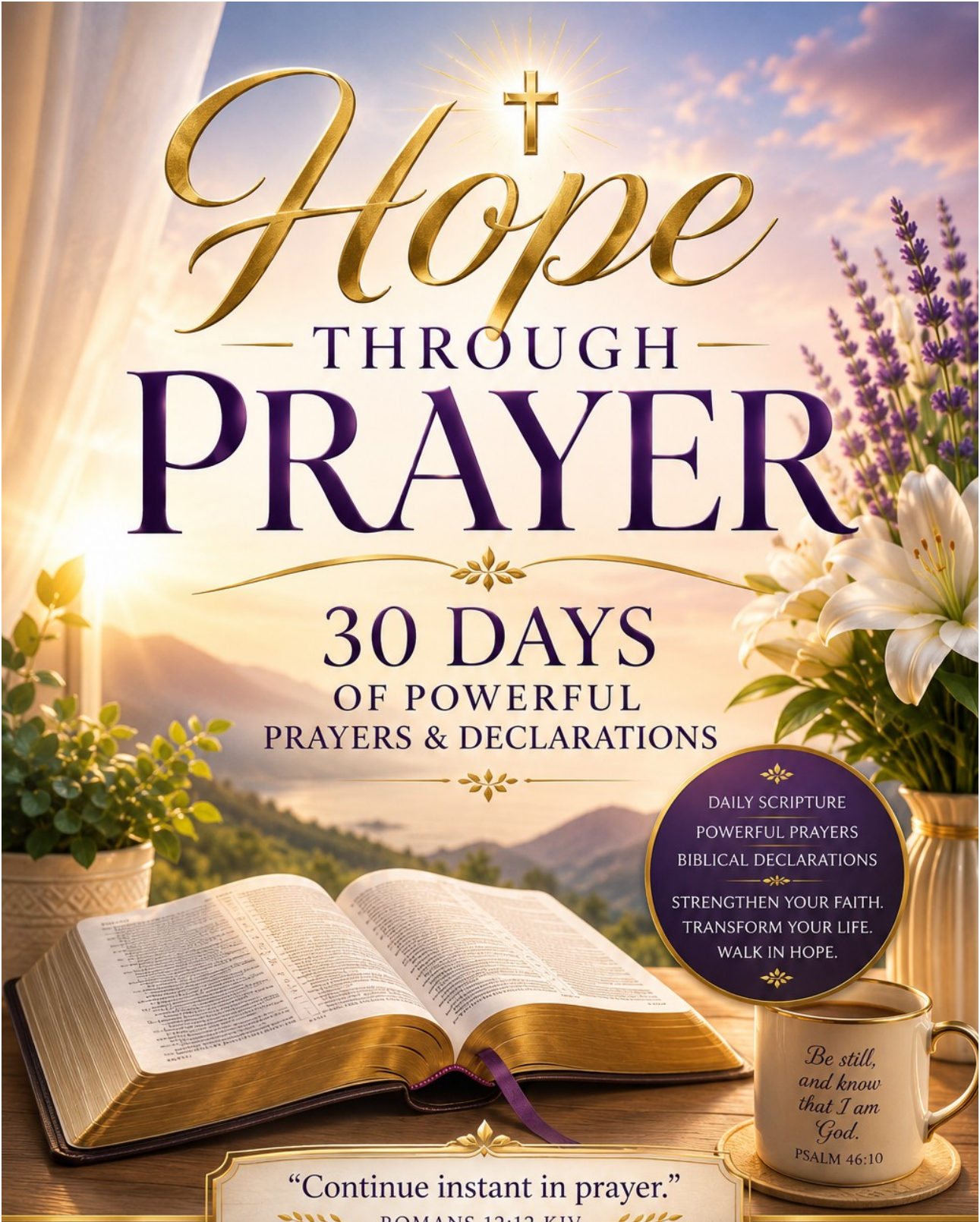

WELCOME TO HOPE THROUGH PRAYER

Prayer is more than bringing a list of requests before God.

Prayer is fellowship with God.

It is thanksgiving. It is worship. It is surrender. It is intercession. It is bringing our burdens before the Lord and trusting Him with the outcome.

Throughout these 30 days, you will be encouraged to begin with the Word of God, spend time in worship, pray according to Scripture, and speak biblical declarations over your life.

Some days you may come before God rejoicing. Other days you may come tired, discouraged, uncertain, or waiting for an answer.

Come anyway.

God does not require perfect words before you can pray. Come with an honest heart.

Bring your thanksgiving. Bring your questions. Bring your family. Bring your needs. Bring your hopes. Bring your concerns.

And above everything else, come seeking God Himself.

My prayer is that these 30 days will not simply give you something to read. May they help you develop a deeper and more consistent life of prayer, worship, Scripture, and trust in Jesus Christ.

HOW TO USE THIS 30-DAY DEVOTIONAL

Set aside a quiet time each day when possible. You may use this devotional in the morning, evening, or whenever you can give God your focused attention.

1. Scripture for Today

Begin with God's Word. Read the Scripture slowly. If possible, read it aloud and consider what God is teaching through the passage.

2. Today's Encouragement

Read the short devotional message and consider how the Scripture applies to your life.

3. Worship Before You Pray

Do not rush past this section. Take a few minutes to worship God before beginning the written prayer. Sing one or two worship songs, unless that day's devotional gives you a different worship direction. You may use familiar Christian worship songs, hymns, or simply worship God in your own words.

Psalm 95:6 (KJV): O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

4. Prayer

Use the written prayer as a guide, but do not feel restricted to the words on the page. Speak personally to God. Add the names of your family members. Tell Him about your circumstances. Bring specific needs before Him.

5. Scripture Declarations

Speak the declarations aloud when possible. These declarations are not about trying to control circumstances with our words. They are about bringing our thoughts and confession into agreement with the Word of God.

6. Today's Prayer Focus

Complete the simple prayer activity for that day. Some days you will give thanks. Some days you will pray for another person. Some days you will surrender a concern. Some days you will reflect upon what God has already done.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN DAY 1

Find a quiet place. Have your Bible nearby. If you keep a prayer journal, have it with you. Remove unnecessary distractions for a few minutes. Then begin with worship.

You are not beginning a religious exercise. You are setting aside time to seek the living God through Jesus Christ.

Colossians 4:2 (KJV): Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving.

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DAY 1

BEGIN WITH THANKSGIVING

Scripture for Today

Psalm 100:4-5 (KJV)

“Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.”

Today's Encouragement

Before asking God for anything today, begin by remembering who He is and what He has already done.

Thanksgiving turns our attention away from what is missing and places our focus upon the goodness and faithfulness of God. Every new day is evidence of His mercy.

God has answered prayers. He has protected us from dangers seen and unseen. He has provided strength during difficult seasons. He has opened doors, closed doors, sustained us, corrected us, and carried us.

Above all, we have salvation through Jesus Christ.

Even while you are waiting for an answer, you can worship. Your thanksgiving is not based solely upon your circumstances. It is rooted in the unchanging character of God.

He is good. He is faithful. His mercy is everlasting.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs that turn your attention completely toward God. Do not rush. Praise Him for who He is before speaking about what you need.

Psalm 95:6 (KJV): O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I come before You with thanksgiving, praise, and adoration.

Thank You for life. Thank You for Your goodness, mercy, grace, protection, provision, and faithfulness.

Above all, thank You for Jesus Christ. Thank You for salvation and for the blood that was shed for me.

Forgive me for the times I have concentrated more upon what I lack than upon what You have already done.

Today I choose thanksgiving.

Thank You for answered prayers and for the matters I am still trusting You with. Thank You for doors You opened and doors You prevented me from entering.

Whatever this day brings, remind me that You are still God, You are still good, and You are still faithful.

Order my steps according to Your Word. Let my thoughts, words, decisions, and actions glorify You.

In the mighty name of Jesus Christ.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 118:24: This is the day which the LORD hath made; I will rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalm 34:1: I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalm 121:8: The LORD shall preserve my going out and my coming in.

Today's Prayer Focus

Name five specific things for which you are thankful. Thank God for each one individually.

DAY 2

SURRENDER THE DAY TO GOD

Scripture for Today

Proverbs 3:5-6 (KJV)

“Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.”

Today's Encouragement

Prayer is not only asking God to bless plans we have already made. Prayer is also surrender.

There will be moments when you do not know what decision to make or which direction to take. God sees beyond what you can see.

Surrender does not mean doing nothing. It means refusing to place your confidence solely in your own understanding.

Place your plans, relationships, responsibilities, opportunities, and decisions before God. Ask Him to lead you according to His will.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs of surrender and worship. As you worship, consciously place your plans before God.

Tell Him, Lord, I want Your will more than my own.

Prayer

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I surrender this day to You.

I acknowledge that I need Your wisdom and direction. Keep me from depending solely upon my own understanding.

Guide my decisions. Order my steps. Close every door that is outside Your will and lead me through the doors You have appointed for me.

Remove confusion and impatience. Give me a heart that is willing to obey even when Your direction differs from what I expected.

Let Your Word govern my choices and Your Spirit lead me in truth.

I commit my plans, responsibilities, family, work, ministry, finances, and future into Your hands.

Let Your will be done.

In Jesus Christ's name.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 37:5: I commit my way unto the LORD and trust in Him.

Psalm 32:8: The Lord will instruct me and teach me in the way I should go.

Proverbs 16:9: I may devise my way, but the LORD directs my steps.

Today's Prayer Focus

Place one important decision before God and ask Him for wisdom rather than rushing ahead.

DAY 3

SEEK GOD FIRST

Scripture for Today

Matthew 6:33 (KJV)

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

Today's Encouragement

Many things compete for first place in our lives: responsibilities, finances, relationships, goals, worries, and ambitions.

Jesus gives us a different order: seek God first.

Putting God first does not mean ignoring responsibilities. It means allowing your relationship with Him to govern everything else.

Before checking what everyone else is saying, seek God. Before allowing worry to dominate your thoughts, seek God. Before making important decisions, seek God.

Worship Before You Pray

Spend several minutes worshipping God without asking for anything.

Sing one or two worship songs simply because He is worthy.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, help me to seek You first.

Forgive me for allowing other things to occupy the place that belongs to You.

Create in me a hunger for Your Word and a desire for Your presence. Teach me to value righteousness more than recognition and obedience more than convenience.

Let my priorities come into alignment with Your kingdom.

May my life reflect Jesus Christ in my home, relationships, work, ministry, and private decisions.

In Jesus Christ's name.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 63:1: O God, Thou art my God; early will I seek Thee.

Psalm 27:8: My heart says unto You, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.

James 4:8: I draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to me.

Today's Prayer Focus

Give God the first part of your attention today before becoming consumed with other responsibilities.

DAY 4

ASK GOD FOR WISDOM

Scripture for Today

James 1:5 (KJV)

“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally... and it shall be given him.”

Today's Encouragement

Not every problem requires more effort. Sometimes what we need most is wisdom.

Wisdom helps us know when to speak, when to remain silent, when to move, when to wait, and how to respond.

God invites us to ask Him.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs acknowledging God as all-knowing and all-wise.

Then become quiet before Him.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I ask You for wisdom.

Give me wisdom for my family, finances, relationships, responsibilities, work, ministry, and decisions.

Protect me from emotional decisions and impulsive reactions.

Help me recognize good counsel and reject advice contrary to Your Word.

Give me discernment to recognize what is from You and what is not.

In Jesus Christ's name.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Proverbs 2:6: The LORD giveth wisdom.

Proverbs 4:7: Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore I will get wisdom.

Colossians 1:9: I pray to be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding.

Today's Prayer Focus

Ask God specifically for wisdom concerning one situation you are presently facing.

DAY 5

RECEIVE GOD'S PEACE

Scripture for Today

Philippians 4:6-7 (KJV)

“Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.”

Today's Encouragement

God does not tell us to pretend problems do not exist. He tells us what to do with our concerns: bring them to Him in prayer.

Prayer moves the burden from your hands into God's hands.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two quiet worship songs. Slow your thoughts and focus on the presence and faithfulness of God.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I bring every concern before You.

I surrender anxiety, fear, uncertainty, and every troubling thought.

Guard my heart and mind through Christ Jesus.

Help me refuse to rehearse worst-case scenarios. Teach me to pray instead of panic.

Let Your peace rule within me today.

In Jesus Christ's name.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

John 14:27: Christ has given me His peace.

Isaiah 26:3: God keeps in perfect peace the mind that is stayed upon Him.

Colossians 3:15: I allow the peace of God to rule in my heart.

Today's Prayer Focus

Write down one worry. Pray specifically about it and consciously place it into God's hands.

DAY 6

STRENGTH FOR THE WEARY

Scripture for Today

Isaiah 40:31 (KJV)

“But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength...”

Today's Encouragement

There are seasons when tiredness reaches beyond the body.

God does not condemn the weary person for needing strength. He invites us to wait upon Him and receive renewal.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs celebrating God's strength and faithfulness.

Prayer

Father, I come to You in the name of Jesus Christ.

Where I am weary, renew me. Where I am discouraged, strengthen me.

Give me strength to fulfill today's responsibilities without becoming overwhelmed by tomorrow.

Help me rest when I need rest and move when You tell me to move.

Let Your strength be made perfect in my weakness.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 28:7: The LORD is my strength and my shield.

Philippians 4:13: I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Psalm 46:1: God is my refuge and strength.

Today's Prayer Focus

Tell God honestly where you feel tired and ask Him for strength for today.

DAY 7

TRUST GOD WHILE YOU WAIT

Scripture for Today

Psalms 27:14 (KJV)

“Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart...”

Today's Encouragement

Waiting can test faith because we often interpret delay as denial.

But God is not limited by our timetable.

Waiting upon God means continuing to trust His character while the answer has not yet appeared.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs about trusting God. Worship Him before the answer arrives.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, strengthen me while I wait.

Keep impatience from pushing me ahead of You.

Where I do not understand Your timing, help me trust Your character.

Give me courage to remain faithful in the waiting season.

I place the timing and outcome into Your hands.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 130:5: I wait for the LORD, and in His Word do I hope.

Lamentations 3:25: The LORD is good unto them that wait for Him.

Isaiah 30:18: Blessed are all they that wait for Him.

Today's Prayer Focus

Identify something you have been waiting for. Surrender both the answer and the timing to God.

DAY 8

PRAY FOR YOUR FAMILY

Scripture for Today

Joshua 24:15 (KJV)

“...as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.”

Today's Encouragement

Your family needs more than your concern. They need your prayers.

Pray for salvation, wisdom, protection, unity, healing of relationships, godly decisions, and spiritual growth.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs and thank God for every family member by name.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I bring my family before You.

Draw each person closer to You. Let salvation come to those who do not know Jesus Christ.

Protect our relationships from bitterness, division, unforgiveness, and strife.

Give parents wisdom. Guide children and young people. Strengthen marriages. Comfort those who are grieving.

Let our homes become places where Your name is honored.

In Jesus Christ's name.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Acts 16:31: I believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and pray for salvation in my household.

Psalms 133:1: May we dwell together in unity.

Isaiah 54:13: May our children be taught of the LORD.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray for each immediate family member by name.

DAY 9

GOD IS YOUR PROVIDER

Scripture for Today

Philippians 4:19 (KJV)

“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

Today's Encouragement

Financial pressure can become mentally exhausting, but fear must not become our master.

God calls us to trust Him while also walking in wisdom, diligence, stewardship, and integrity.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs thanking God as your Provider.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, thank You for being my Provider.

Give me wisdom concerning money. Teach me to manage what You place in my hands.

Provide employment, opportunities, resources, and legitimate means of provision according to Your will.

Protect me from fear, greed, waste, and dishonest gain.

Help me remain generous, responsible, and grateful.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 23:1: The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Matthew 6:31-32: My heavenly Father knows what I need.

Psalm 37:25: God is faithful to His people.

Today's Prayer Focus

Bring your financial needs before God specifically and ask Him for both provision and wisdom.

DAY 10

PRAY FOR PROTECTION

Scripture for Today

Psalm 121:7-8 (KJV)

“The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.”

Today's Encouragement

We cannot see everything ahead of us, but God can.

Prayer for protection is not an invitation to fear. It is an expression of trust.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs declaring God to be your refuge and keeper.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I commit myself and my loved ones into Your hands.

Preserve our going out and coming in.

Grant wisdom on the road, at work, at school, at home, and wherever we travel.

Deliver us from dangers seen and unseen.

Keep our hearts from living in fear. Let our confidence remain in You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 91:2: The LORD is my refuge and my fortress.

Psalm 121:5: The LORD is my keeper.

Proverbs 18:10: The name of the LORD is a strong tower.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray specifically for everyone in your household as they go out and come in.

DAY 11

LET GOD HEAL THE HEART

Scripture for Today

Psalms 147:3 (KJV)

“He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.”

Today's Encouragement

Some wounds cannot be seen.

People may continue functioning while carrying disappointment, rejection, betrayal, or grief.

God cares about the hidden places too.

Worship Before You Pray

Choose one or two worship songs that remind you of God's love, compassion, and nearness.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I bring the wounded places of my heart before You.

Heal what disappointment has damaged.

Help me forgive where forgiveness is needed without calling wrong right.

Remove bitterness and resentment.

Restore joy, peace, and spiritual strength.

Let what happened to me never become greater in my heart than what Jesus Christ has done for me.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 34:18: The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart.

Psalms 30:5: Weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

Isaiah 61:3: God gives beauty for ashes and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

Today's Prayer Focus

Tell God about one hurt you have been carrying.

DAY 12

CHOOSE FORGIVENESS

Scripture for Today

Ephesians 4:31-32 (KJV)

“...forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.”

Today's Encouragement

Forgiveness does not mean pretending something did not happen. It does not require remaining in unsafe circumstances.

Forgiveness means refusing to allow bitterness to rule your heart.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs thanking Jesus Christ for His mercy and forgiveness toward you.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, search my heart.

Show me where resentment has taken root.

Because You have forgiven me, help me forgive others.

Give me wisdom concerning boundaries and reconciliation, but keep bitterness out of my heart.

I release vengeance into Your hands.

Create in me a clean heart.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Colossians 3:13: As Christ forgave me, I choose to forgive.

Romans 12:19: Vengeance belongs unto the Lord.

Psalms 51:10: Create in me a clean heart, O God.

Today's Prayer Focus

Bring one difficult relationship before God and ask Him to cleanse your heart.

DAY 13

COURAGE OVER FEAR

Scripture for Today

2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)

“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”

Today's Encouragement

Fear often speaks about what might happen.

Faith remembers who God is.

Courage is not pretending there is no challenge. Courage is obeying God despite the challenge.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs declaring God's power and sovereignty.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, deliver me from fear that controls my decisions.

Give me a sound mind.

When fear speaks loudly, remind me of Your Word.

Give me courage to obey You, courage to speak truth with love, and courage to move when You direct me.

My confidence is in You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Isaiah 41:10: I will fear not, for God is with me.

Psalms 56:3: What time I am afraid, I will trust in Thee.

Joshua 1:9: I will be strong and of a good courage.

Today's Prayer Focus

Name one fear before God and answer it with Scripture.

DAY 14

GUARD YOUR MIND

Scripture for Today

Philippians 4:8 (KJV)

“Whatsoever things are true... honest... just... pure... lovely... of good report... think on these things.”

Today's Encouragement

Not every thought deserves a permanent place in your mind.

The Word of God gives us a standard by which our thinking can be examined.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs centered on Jesus Christ and His truth.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, guard my mind.

Expose thoughts rooted in fear, bitterness, envy, condemnation, or deception.

Help me meditate upon Your Word.

Renew my mind and teach me to bring my thoughts into obedience to Christ.

Let what I watch, hear, read, and entertain strengthen rather than corrupt my spiritual life.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Romans 12:2: I am transformed by the renewing of my mind.

2 Corinthians 10:5: I bring thoughts into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

Isaiah 26:3: My mind will remain stayed upon God.

Today's Prayer Focus

Replace one recurring negative thought with a Scripture truth.

DAY 15

GOD'S WORD WILL GUIDE YOU

Scripture for Today

Psalms 119:105 (KJV)

"Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

Today's Encouragement

We live in a world filled with opinions. God's Word must remain our standard.

Scripture corrects, teaches, warns, comforts, and directs us.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs honoring God for His truth and faithfulness.

Then read today's Scripture aloud.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, give me a deeper love for Your Word.

Teach me Your statutes.

Correct me where I am wrong and strengthen me where I am weak.

Keep me from adjusting Scripture to suit my desires.

Let Your Word shape my beliefs, choices, relationships, and conduct.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 119:11: I hide God's Word in my heart.

Joshua 1:8: I will meditate in the Word day and night.

John 17:17: God's Word is truth.

Today's Prayer Focus

Read a portion of Scripture slowly today and ask, Lord, what are You teaching me?

DAY 16

PRAY FOR YOUR HEALTH AND STRENGTH

Scripture for Today

3 John 2 (KJV)

“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.”

Today's Encouragement

Our bodies are gifts entrusted to us, and health concerns are appropriate matters to bring before God.

Prayer and responsible care are not enemies. We can pray while also seeking appropriate medical care, rest, nutrition, and wise counsel when needed.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs praising God as Creator and Sustainer.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I bring my body and health before You.

Give strength where there is weakness and comfort where there is pain.

Grant wisdom to doctors, nurses, caregivers, and everyone involved in medical decisions.

Help me make wise choices concerning rest, nutrition, movement, and care.

Strengthen my body so that I may fulfill the responsibilities You have given me.

In all things, let Your grace sustain me.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 103:2: I will bless the LORD and forget not all His benefits.

Isaiah 40:29: He giveth power to the faint.

Psalm 73:26: God is the strength of my heart.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray specifically for your health and for someone else who needs physical strength.

DAY 17

PRAY FOR YOUR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

Scripture for Today

Isaiah 54:13 (KJV)

“And all thy children shall be taught of the LORD; and great shall be the peace of thy children.”

Today's Encouragement

Children and young people face pressures previous generations encountered differently.

They need more than rules. They need prayer, godly instruction, wisdom, protection, and examples of genuine faith.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs and place the names of children and young people before God.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I bring our children and young people before You.

Draw them to Jesus Christ.

Protect their minds and hearts.

Give them wisdom concerning friendships, relationships, education, technology, entertainment, and decisions.

Place godly influences around them.

Protect them from violence, exploitation, addiction, deception, and destructive choices.

Let them know Your truth and walk in it.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Proverbs 22:6: We will train children in the way they should go.

Psalms 127:3: Children are an heritage of the LORD.

Isaiah 54:13: Great shall be the peace of our children.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray for at least three young people by name.

DAY 18

PRAY FOR YOUR HOME

Scripture for Today

Psalms 127:1 (KJV)

“Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it...”

Today's Encouragement

A beautiful building does not automatically create a peaceful home.

Invite God into the atmosphere, relationships, decisions, and conversations within your household.

Worship Before You Pray

Play or sing one or two worship songs in your home. Let praise fill the atmosphere.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I dedicate my home to You.

Let peace dwell here.

Remove strife, hostility, bitterness, confusion, and unforgiveness.

Give us wisdom in how we speak to one another.

Let this home be a place of prayer, love, safety, truth, hospitality, and worship.

May Jesus Christ be honored here.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Joshua 24:15: As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Psalms 133:1: We will seek to dwell together in unity.

Proverbs 24:3: Through wisdom is an house builded.

Today's Prayer Focus

Walk through your home and thank God for it. Pray for the people who live there.

DAY 19

PRAY FOR YOUR WORK AND PURPOSE

Scripture for Today

Colossians 3:23 (KJV)

Today's Encouragement

Purpose is not limited to a title, platform, or public ministry.

Whatever God has placed in your hands should be handled faithfully.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs and surrender your work, gifts, ministry, and abilities to God.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, thank You for every gift and ability You have entrusted to me.

Show me how to use them for Your glory.

Bless the work of my hands according to Your will.

Give me discipline, creativity, integrity, excellence, and perseverance.

Keep me from comparing my assignment with someone else's.

Let my work honor You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 90:17: Establish Thou the work of our hands.

Proverbs 16:3: I commit my works unto the LORD.

1 Corinthians 10:31: Whatever I do, I will seek to do all to the glory of God.

Today's Prayer Focus

Ask God how you can honor Him through the work already in your hands.

DAY 20

PRAY FOR OPEN DOORS AND CLOSED DOORS

Scripture for Today

Revelation 3:7 (KJV)

“...he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth.”

Today's Encouragement

Not every open door is God's door, and not every closed door is rejection.

We need discernment more than opportunity.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs acknowledging Jesus Christ as Lord over your future.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, govern every opportunity before me.

Open doors that agree with Your will.

Close doors that would distract, damage, compromise, or divert me.

Give me discernment so I do not mistake temptation for opportunity.

Keep me from forcing doors You have closed.

I trust You with what You permit and what You prevent.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 84:11: No good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Proverbs 3:6: I acknowledge God, and He directs my paths.

Psalms 37:23: The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD.

Today's Prayer Focus

Place one opportunity before God and ask for discernment rather than merely asking Him to make it happen.

DAY 21

WHEN YOU NEED A FRESH START

Scripture for Today

Lamentations 3:22-23 (KJV)

“It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed... They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.”

Today's Encouragement

Yesterday cannot be rewritten, but today can be surrendered to God.

Failure does not give us permission to remain in sin, but neither should repentance leave us trapped in endless condemnation.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs thanking God for mercy, grace, and faithfulness.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, thank You for mercy that is new every morning.

Where I have sinned, I repent.

Where I have made poor decisions, give me wisdom to correct what can be corrected.

Deliver me from condemnation and from repeating destructive patterns.

Help me learn, grow, obey, and move forward with You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

1 John 1:9: If I confess my sins, God is faithful and just to forgive.

Psalms 51:10: Create in me a clean heart, O God.

Philippians 3:13: I reach forth unto those things which are before.

Today's Prayer Focus

Confess what needs to be confessed, receive God's forgiveness, and identify one change you need to make.

DAY 22

PRAY WHEN YOU FEEL DISCOURAGED

Scripture for Today

Psalm 42:11 (KJV)

“Why art thou cast down, O my soul?... hope thou in God...”

Today's Encouragement

Discouragement can make temporary circumstances feel permanent.

The psalmist spoke directly to his own soul and redirected his hope toward God.

You can do the same.

Worship Before You Pray

Even if you do not feel like singing, sing one or two worship songs anyway. Let worship lead your emotions rather than waiting for your emotions to lead worship.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, meet me in this place of discouragement.

Lift my eyes beyond what I presently see.

Remind me of Your faithfulness.

Give me strength to continue doing what is right even when results seem slow.

Restore hope, joy, courage, and expectation according to Your will.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 31:24: I will be of good courage as I hope in the LORD.

Galatians 6:9: I will not be weary in well doing.

Romans 15:13: May the God of hope fill me with joy and peace in believing.

Today's Prayer Focus

Write down three ways God has helped you through difficult seasons before.

DAY 23

WALK IN LOVE

Scripture for Today

1 Corinthians 13:4-5 (KJV)

“Charity suffereth long, and is kind... seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil.”

Today's Encouragement

Love is more than emotion.

Biblical love affects how we speak, respond, forgive, serve, correct, and treat people.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs thanking Jesus for His love.

Ask God to make that love visible through your conduct.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, teach me to walk in love.

Help me be patient, kind, truthful, humble, and slow to become angry.

Guard my tongue.

Show me where selfishness, pride, envy, or resentment has influenced my behavior.

Help me love people without compromising truth.

May others see Christ in the way I treat them.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

John 13:35: I desire that Christ's love be evident in my life.

1 John 4:19: I love because He first loved me.

Ephesians 4:2: Help me walk with humility, meekness, longsuffering, and love.

Today's Prayer Focus

Ask God to show you one practical way to demonstrate Christlike love today.

DAY 24

WATCH YOUR WORDS

Scripture for Today

Proverbs 18:21 (KJV)

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue...”

Today's Encouragement

Words can encourage, instruct, comfort, correct, wound, deceive, or destroy.

Prayer should affect the way we speak after we say Amen.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs of praise. Then ask God to make your mouth an instrument that honors Him.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, set a watch before my mouth.

Forgive me for words spoken carelessly, angrily, dishonestly, or unkindly.

Give me wisdom to know when to speak and when to remain silent.

Let my words be truthful and gracious.

Keep gossip, slander, complaining, and destructive speech away from me.

May my mouth glorify You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 19:14: Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Thy sight.

Proverbs 15:1: A soft answer turneth away wrath.

Ephesians 4:29: I will seek to speak what ministers grace unto the hearers.

Today's Prayer Focus

Before speaking during a difficult conversation today, pause and pray.

DAY 25

PRAY FOR LEADERS AND NATIONS

Scripture for Today

1 Timothy 2:1-2 (KJV)

“I exhort therefore, that... prayers... be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority...”

Today's Encouragement

Scripture instructs believers to pray for those in authority.

Our prayers should extend beyond our own households and personal needs.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs declaring that God is sovereign over every nation.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I pray for those in authority.

Grant leaders wisdom, justice, integrity, and sound judgment.

Expose corruption and restrain evil.

Protect the vulnerable.

Give wisdom to those responsible for laws, education, healthcare, public safety, and national decisions.

Strengthen the Church to remain faithful to Jesus Christ and courageous in truth and love.

Let righteousness and justice prevail according to Your will.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 22:28: The kingdom is the LORD'S, and He is governor among the nations.

Proverbs 21:1: The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD.

Micah 6:8: May we do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with God.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray specifically for your nation, community, and those entrusted with public responsibility.

DAY 26

PRAY FOR THE CHURCH

Scripture for Today

Matthew 16:18 (KJV)

“...upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.”

Today's Encouragement

The Church needs prayer.

Pray for pastors, teachers, evangelists, missionaries, intercessors, worship leaders, ministry workers, and believers everywhere.

Pray for truth, holiness, unity, courage, and genuine love.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs centered entirely upon Jesus Christ.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, strengthen Your Church.

Give pastors and ministry leaders wisdom, humility, courage, and integrity.

Protect them from deception, pride, temptation, exhaustion, and compromise.

Let Your Word be preached faithfully.

Bring repentance where correction is needed.

Strengthen persecuted believers.

Let the Church demonstrate truth, holiness, compassion, and love.

May Jesus Christ always remain the center.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Ephesians 5:27: Christ desires a glorious Church.

John 17:17: Sanctify us through Thy truth; Thy Word is truth.

Hebrews 10:24: May believers provoke one another unto love and good works.

Today's Prayer Focus

Pray for your local church and at least one ministry leader by name.

DAY 27

PRAY FOR THOSE WHO NEED SALVATION

Scripture for Today

2 Peter 3:9 (KJV)

“The Lord is... not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.”

Today's Encouragement

Never become so focused on personal blessings that you forget people who need Jesus Christ.

Salvation is greater than material success.

Pray for hearts to be opened to the Gospel.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs about Jesus Christ, the cross, His love, and salvation.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, I pray for those who do not know Christ.

Open hearts to the Gospel.

Send faithful witnesses across their paths.

Remove spiritual blindness and deception.

Give believers courage and wisdom to share the Gospel with love and truth.

Let prodigals return to You.

May many repent, believe upon Jesus Christ, and receive salvation.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

John 3:16: God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son.

Acts 4:12: Salvation is found in Jesus Christ.

Romans 10:13: Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Today's Prayer Focus

Write down the names of three people who need salvation and pray for them consistently.

DAY 28

REMEMBER GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Scripture for Today

Psalms 77:11 (KJV)

"I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember thy wonders of old."

Today's Encouragement

Sometimes faith for today is strengthened by remembering yesterday.

Think about prayers God answered, doors He opened, dangers He brought you through, and times He sustained you when you thought you could not continue.

Your testimony is evidence that God has already been faithful.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two worship songs that remind you of God's past faithfulness.

Then spend a few minutes remembering what He has done personally for you.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, thank You for Your faithfulness throughout my life.

Forgive me for forgetting so quickly what You have already done.

When present circumstances seem difficult, remind me of previous victories, answered prayers, provision, protection, and grace.

May remembrance produce gratitude rather than pride.

All glory belongs to You.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalms 103:2: I will bless the LORD and forget not all His benefits.

1 Samuel 7:12: Hitherto hath the LORD helped us.

Psalms 126:3: The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.

Today's Prayer Focus

Write down five things God has brought you through. Keep them as a testimony of His faithfulness.

DAY 29

KEEP GOING IN FAITH

Scripture for Today

Galatians 6:9 (KJV)

“And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.”

Today's Encouragement

Some victories come because a person simply refused to abandon obedience.

There will be moments when progress feels slow.

Do not measure God's faithfulness solely by immediate results.

Continue praying. Continue obeying. Continue serving. Continue growing.

Worship Before You Pray

Sing one or two songs that strengthen your faith and remind you of God's promises.

Worship Him for the strength to continue.

Prayer

Father, in Jesus Christ's name, strengthen me to continue.

Where I have become weary, renew me.

Protect me from quitting what You have genuinely called me to do simply because progress is slower than expected.

At the same time, give me wisdom to release anything You never assigned to me.

Give me perseverance without stubbornness, faith without presumption, and patience without passivity.

I trust You with the results.

Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Philippians 1:6: He which hath begun a good work will perform it.

Hebrews 10:36: I have need of patience after doing the will of God.

1 Corinthians 15:58: I will be steadfast and always abounding in the work of the Lord.

Today's Prayer Focus

Ask yourself: What has God truly called me to continue doing? Pray for renewed strength to remain faithful.

DAY 30

GIVE GOD THE GLORY

Scripture for Today

Psalm 115:1 (KJV)

“Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy truth's sake.”

Today's Encouragement

Thirty days of prayer should not end with greater confidence in ourselves. It should end with greater confidence in God.

Prayer is not a formula for controlling outcomes.

Prayer is relationship, surrender, worship, dependence, thanksgiving, intercession, listening, and trust.

Perhaps God answered some prayers during these thirty days. Perhaps other answers are still unfolding. Perhaps some circumstances have not changed yet, but God has been changing you.

Whatever God does next, give Him the glory.

Do not stop praying because the thirty days are finished.

Let prayer become part of the rhythm of your life.

Worship Before You Pray

Today, spend longer in worship.

Sing two or three worship songs if you are able.

Do not begin by asking for anything. Praise God for His holiness. Thank Him for Jesus Christ, salvation, His Word, and for carrying you through these thirty days.

Then tell Him: Lord, all the glory belongs to You.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, I thank You for bringing me through these thirty days of prayer.

Thank You for every Scripture I have read, every moment of worship, every prayer spoken aloud, and every prayer whispered from my heart.

Thank You for the answers I have already seen and for the matters that remain in Your hands. Father, do not allow me to leave this thirty-day journey and return to prayerlessness. Create in me a consistent prayer life. Give me a continuing hunger for Your Word. Teach me to worship You when things are going well and when circumstances are difficult. Help me seek Your will rather than merely asking You to approve mine. Make me sensitive to the needs of others so that my prayers are not centered only upon myself. Keep my heart humble. If You open doors, provide, heal, restore, deliver, strengthen, or promote, I will give You the glory. And while I wait for answers, I will still worship You. My hope is not in possessions. My hope is not in people. My hope is not in circumstances. My hope is in You. I surrender my future into Your hands. Continue to order my steps according to Your Word. May my life testify that Jesus Christ is Lord. Not unto me, O Lord, but unto Your name be all glory, honor, and praise. In the mighty and precious name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Scripture Declarations

Psalm 115:1: Not unto us, O LORD, but unto Thy name give glory.

Psalm 150:6: Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD.

Romans 12:12: I will rejoice in hope, remain patient in tribulation, and continue instant in prayer.

Psalm 34:1: I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalm 121:8: The LORD shall preserve my going out and my coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.

Today's Prayer Focus

Look back over the previous 29 days. Write down prayers God has answered, Scriptures that strengthened you, areas where God corrected or changed you, matters you are still trusting Him with, and people you will continue praying for.

CONTINUE IN PRAYER

You have completed thirty days, but your conversation with God continues.

Romans 12:12 (KJV): Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer.

Keep praying.

Keep reading the Word.

Keep worshipping.

Keep trusting God.

And above everything else, keep your eyes upon Jesus Christ.
